On March 10, 1944, Shirley May (Campbell) Craig was born in Tempe, Arizona. Daughter of the late William Jefferson Campbell and Rowena May (Collins) Campbell, Shirley grew up in Arizona and Washington. She went to school in various places but mostly in Olympia, Washington where she graduated.
