Shirley Ann Stewart, daughter of the late Dorsey and Thelma Irene (Jones) Alexander, was born January 1, 1937 in Stoutland, Missouri.

As a young girl, Shirley and her siblings were taken in by their grandparents and were raised by them. It was during this time that they attended Sunday School and Shirley was baptized.
