Song Hoe Kim, son of the late Yong Teuk Kim and Ui Ju Kim, was born April 14, 1943, in Daegu, South Korea. As a young boy, he grew up in Ueuseong Village, South Korea and attended the Andong Kim Ancestors of South Korea school.

As a young man, Song faithfully served with the Republic of Korea Army.

On April 23, 1971, Song was united in marriage to Pyong Nan Kim (Lee). They were blessed with three children and many wonderful years of memories together before she preceded him in death.

Song and Pyong came to the United States where they raised their three children. They were very proud of them and their accomplishments.

After moving to the Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri area, Song began working on the installation. He first began working as a bagger at the commissary before becoming employed with EDP Enterprises where he retired.

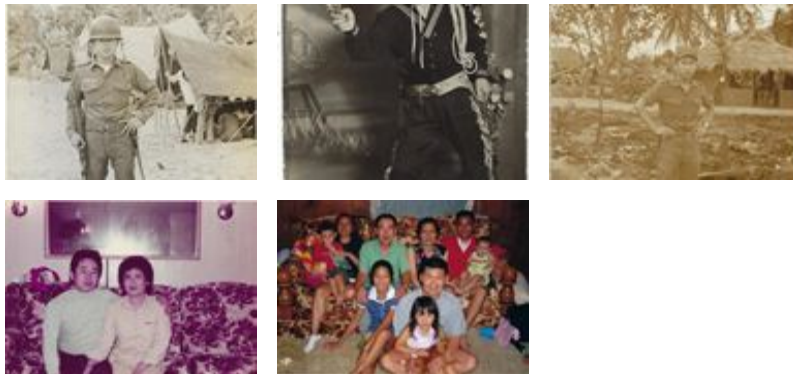

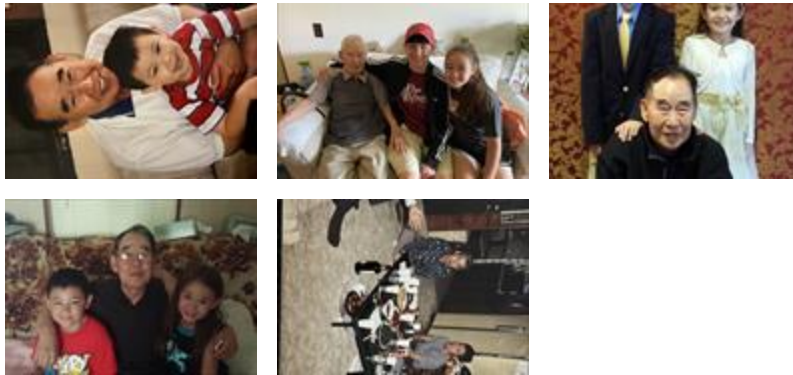
