SPC Thomas Issiah Johnston, beloved son of Tony John and Melissa Dawn (Sander) Johnston was born October, 11, 1994 in Osage Beach, Missouri. Thomas grew up near Stoutland, Missouri where he attended school and was a member of the FFA and cross country team. Thomas graduated from Stoutland High School in 2014.

After graduation Thomas entered into the United States Army completing his basic training at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. He was assigned in 2015 to serve over in South Korea for 2 years and was then assigned to Fort Drum in New York. While proudly serving in the Army Thomas became a Chemical Radiological, Biological and Nuclear Specialist and was currently serving in the National Guard in Springfield, Missouri. While in the Army, he received the Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal, Korean Defense Service Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon and Marksmanship Badge with Rifle Bar.

Thomas greatly enjoyed the outdoors whether fishing, working on his truck, riding anything with a motor, “especially motors he and Tyler built,” he also liked playing video games, reading books, music and hanging out with his family and friends.

Thomas passed away at his home on the morning of Saturday, January 12,

2019, having attained the age of 24 years.

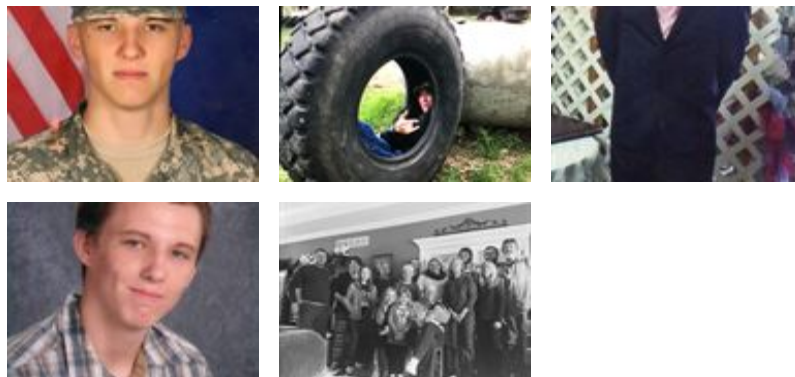
