SSG (Ret) Ronald Hansen, son of the late John and Alvina (Maas) Hansen, was born September 30, 1933 in Battle Creek, Iowa where he grew up and graduated from high school.

In 1953 at the age of 20, Ron enlisted in the United States Army and served his country until his retirement in 1973 after 20 years of service. He earned various awards and commendations for his faithful service. He served in Korea and Vietnam. He earned the rank of Staff Sergeant.

On January 20, 1965, Ron was united in marriage to Beatrice Pauline Franklin in Colorado Springs, Colorado. They shared over 37 years of marriage together before she preceded him in death on May 15, 2002.

Ron went home to be with his Lord Saturday, April 25, 2009 at the age of 75 years, 6 months and 26 days.
