



## Sylvia Beverly (Young) Theberge

Sylvia Beverly (Young) Theberge, daughter of the late Kenneth Chapman and Winnie (Edwards) Young, was born September 9, 1934 in Reading, Massachusetts. As a young girl, Sylvia grew up in Laurence, Massachusetts and graduated from Laurence High School in 1952.

Shortly after graduating, Sylvia met a young soldier by the name of Charles Theberge. They were united in marriage on January 4, 1954 and were blessed with two daughters and eight sons.

Due to Charles being in the military, the family was transferred several places, but in 1965 they came to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri from Germany. They decided to remain in the area to raise their family after Charles was honorably discharged from the military.

Besides raising her family, which was a full time job, she enjoyed being outdoors while working in her garden and she was very creative in when it came to drawing, painting and sewing. She also enjoyed shopping.

Sylvia passed away Friday, August 24, 2018 in the Richland Care Center of Waynesville, Missouri having attained the age of 83 years. She will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved her.
