Tami Caye Hoskins, age 51, of Columbia, MO passed away Wednesday, Sept. 20, 2017, in her home in Columbia, MO., surrounded by family members after a courageous battle with brain cancer for 3 and a half years.

Tami was born in Sullivan, MO., on August 21, 1966. She attended Gasconade R-2 schools, graduating from Owensville High School in 1984. Attended the University of Missouri and graduated from Columbia College in 1989. While in high school she worked for Siegfried Restaurant and First Bank of Owensville. While in College she worked for Boone County National Bank, Mizzou Credit Union, and 1st National Bank.

Tami then started a 24 year career with the University of Missouri, working in University Physicians (Clinics), Department of Surgery – Urology, Human Resources – UM System, and finally working as Executive Staff Assistant to MU Department of Family and Community Medicine Chair Dr. Steve Zweig and Vice Chair Dr. Michael LeFevre.

Tami married Keith Hoskins on June 17, 1989 at Parkade Baptist Church in Columbia and they were both extremely proud parents of Nathan Ray and Matthew James, who survive at home.

Tami loved to read, bake and cook. Her family was her pride and joy and she

fed them well. She also loved to travel and really enjoyed all of the trips they took together to make memories for her family. Tami knew her time was short and made the most out of each trip so her family would have many, many, memories to keep with them after she was gone. Tami's favorite color was red and it is asked of the attendees to wear something red in memory of Tami.

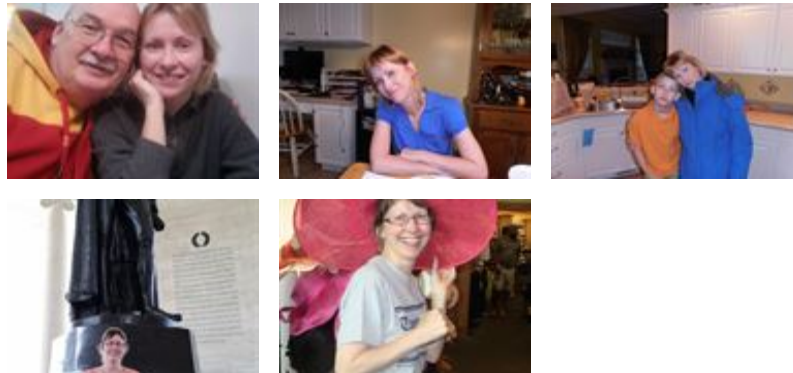
