MSG (Ret) Tautalaso M "Sam" Maulupe, was born May 15, 1957 in America Samoa to the late Tautalasso and Toeliu Maulupe. He grew up in Samoa and as a young man, he entered the United States Army.

Sam served his county faithfully until his retirement. He had attained the rank of Master Sergeant and earned several awards and commendations. At the time of his retirement, Sam was stationed at Fort Leonard Wood.

On August 14, 1979, Sam was united in marriage to the love of his life, Lyla Susan Bingham in Robertson County, Tennessee. They shared over 33 years of marriage together and many wonderful memories.

After Sam's retirement from the military, he was able to spend time doing the things that he enjoyed the most. The majority of the time you could find him outdoors; whether he was on the golf course or working in his yard, he enjoyed being outdoors.
