



Tim Ellzey

June 15, 1964 - October 27, 2008

Timmy Dean Ellzey passed away at 3:47 p.m. Monday, October 27, 2008 at St. John's Regional Medical Center, Springfield, Missouri, at the age of 44 years, 4 months and 12 days, as the result of injuries sustained in an accident doing what he loved to do....riding his motorcycle.

The son of Carroll D. Ellzey and Naiah F. (Goodrich) Ellzey Hogan, Tim was born June 15, 1964 in Mexico, Missouri.

As a young boy, Tim accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior and was baptized at Crooked Creek Baptist Church in Shelbina.

Tim grew up on a farm in north east Missouri, and attended high school in Paris, Missouri. In addition to working on the family farm, he also did farming for others. His life then led him to the state of California for several years, and back to Missouri where he settled in Pulaski County.

Tim was known for his hunting and fishing adventures, which were abundant. He was a gifted auto mechanic and known as the best exhaust man around. There was little he could not figure out how to do.

Tim was a loving companion, father, son, brother and friend. He would help anyone, giving them the shirt off his back, even if he didn't have one to give.

He had a good heart and will never be forgotten.
