Timmy Lee Williams was born October 6, 1960 in Galesburg, Illinois. The son of Tannie Williams and Winifred Mack, he grew up and graduated from Galesburg High School in 1978.

Timmy had a successful, exciting high school career playing basketball and continued this pursuit while attending school at Columbia College. Timmy's love of the game extended to coaching of youth basketball teams and the avid following of his sons' and daughter's basketball careers at Waynesville. Timmy's memories of past matches usually permeated his conversation. Since his arrival at Waynesville, Tim was a die-hard Tiger fan, supporting and cheering on all events, from sports to music to theater. He could always be seen in orange and black.

Tim began a career as the owner of Tim's Plumbing once he moved to Waynesville, working as a contractor and plumber for not only the community but surrounding towns. The ability to assist people as he provided services frequently ended in life long friendships. Tim never knew a stranger.

Tim established his faith in Jesus Christ as a member of the Rock of Ages Church of St. Robert. He served as deacon of the church and he had a deep passion for worship, playing the congo drums on the praise team. His relationship with Jesus formed his pursuit of a unique outreach within the

community. He actively supported youth within the church and the community as a whole, accepting the role of mentor and friend for any child he saw with a need.

Tim went home to be with his Lord on Wednesday, August 29, 2012. He will be deeply missed by all those that knew and loved him.

Tim leaves to cherish his memory his five children: Amanda, Timothy, Tevin and Terin Williams, all of Waynesville and Talisha Williams of Peoria, IL; granddaughter Alisia-Monique Nicholson-Williams of Peoria II; mother and stepfather: Winifred Elaine and Leroy Mack of Peoria, IL; father: Tannie Williams of Galesburg, IL; former wife Kimberly Johnson-Williams of Waynesville; five siblings: Stanley Trent of Atlanta, GA, Roland Williams of Galesburg, IL, Rosemary Williams of Galesburg, IL, Kevin Williams of Etteville, AR and Kenny Cunningham of Dubuque, IA; grandfather: Charles White of Galesburg, IL and several nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

Tim was preceded in death by brother Keith Williams, and Grandmothers, Panthier "Honey" Williams and Alleyene White.
