Ursula Katarina Moske, daughter of the late Adam Perlein and Luise (Klein) Perlein Hartmann, was born April 9, 1945 in Coburg, Germany where she grew up and attended school.

Ursula met the love of her life, a United States soldier, by the name of Michael Paul Moske and they were united in marriage on June 22, 1979. They shared over 39 years of marriage together and seven children: Andrea, Norbert, John, Thomas, Thorsten, Timothy and Kimberly.

Due to Michael being in the military, Ursula and the family were stationed at different areas of the world. The most important thing to her was being a supportive Command Sergeant Major's wife and mother to her children. However, while they were stationed at Fort Leonard Wood during the mid-1980's, Ursula worked at the Quartermaster Laundry as a receiving supervisor.

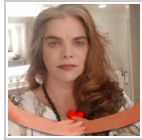
