Wallie Demetris Bradshaw, son of the late Hugh Valentine and Jung Ae (Cho) Bradshaw, was born July 8, 1959 in #284 Bupyung-Dong, Incheon City, Korea. As a young boy, Wallie and his family moved several times due to his father being in the military. They were transferred to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri where Wallie graduated from Waynesville High School.

After graduating from high school, Wallie furthered his education by attending the University of Kansas before entering the United States Air Force. Wallie served his country faithfully for six years and earned the Air Force Achievement Medal, Air Force Training Ribbon and the Air Force Longevity Service Ribbon before his honorable discharge.

In 1989, Wallie met Angilene Faye Jones and they shared the next 29 years together and many wonderful memories.

Wallie enjoyed spending time with friends and especially traveling and taking trips with Angilene. He was a great bowler and was a member of several leagues. He also enjoyed playing basketball and video games and going to movies.

Wallie passed away Tuesday, September 4, 2018, in the Dixon Nursing & Rehab Center of Dixon, Missouri having attained the age of 59 years.

Wallie leaves to cherish his memory, his companion, Angilene, of the home; three sisters, Linda Lathrop, Janet Bradshaw-Hixson, and Rose Endsley; as well as a host of other relatives and friends.

He will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.
