Wanda Williams, daughter of Ben and Fannie (Stokes) Torian, was born December 2, 1955 in Detroit, Michigan. She passed away Friday, January 19, 2018 in the General Leonard Wood Army Community Hospital of Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri having attained the age of 62 years.

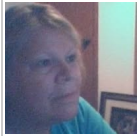

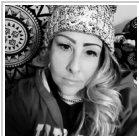

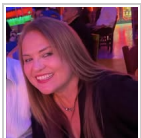
