Wilda F. Webb Altheide Corse, daughter of the late Jesse Alexander and Ellen Idella (Mace) Webb, was born January 14, 1921 in Linn Creek, Missouri. As a young girl, Wilda and her family moved to Lexington, Missouri and stayed there for several years until moving to Kansas.

On March 22, 1946, Wilda was united in marriage to Arnold F. Corse in Las Vegas, Nevada. They shared many wonderful years together and were blessed with three sons: David, Dan and Philip.
