William Dean "Bill" Skidmore, Sr., son of the late Lacy George Skidmore and Mary Frances (Ashworth) Skidmore, was born March 6, 1949, in Waynesville, Missouri. As a young boy, Bill attended Laquey Elementary School before transferring to the Waynesville High School.

Bill entered the United States Army for a very short time before being medically discharged.

Most of Bill's working years was spent as an auto mechanic, but he also did truck driving, auto towing and trailer home transporting. He also worked as a Missouri Trap Shoot mechanic.

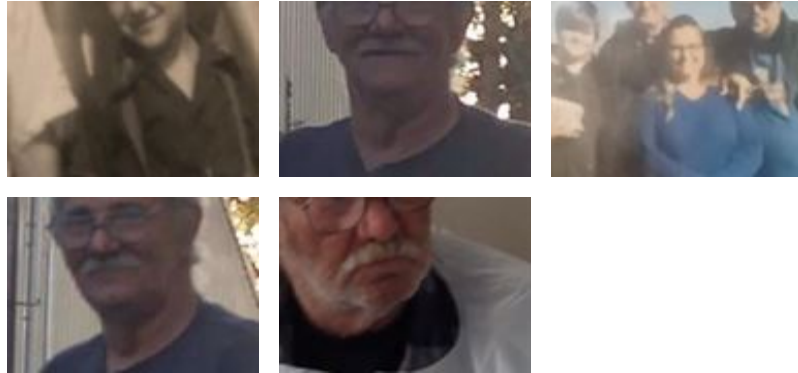
