William Charles "Charlie" Hance, son of the late William and Mary Ellen (Hance) Fenton, was born November 12, 1945 in Dixon, Missouri and passed away at 4:03 a.m. Sunday, March 18, 2012 in the Cox South Hospital of Springfield, Missouri.

Charlie had recently begun attending Maranatha Baptist Church in St. Robert. He was so thankful to Pastor Keith Carnahan for never giving up on him. He loved their almost weekly meeting at the car lot. They had developed a very special friendship and Charlie grew to love his pastor's heart.

Charlie will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved him. 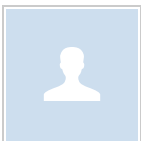

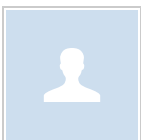
